

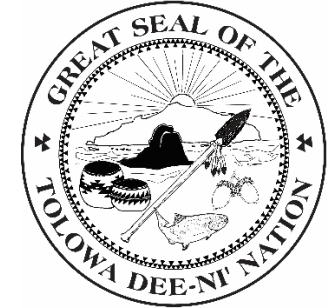
WHAT IS NEEDED TO APPLY?

- 1) An annual application
- 2) An annual release of information
- 3) Government issued ID or driver license
- 4) High school diploma or transcript/GED
- 5) Acceptance letter or email from school
- 6) Class schedule that includes your name,

school's name, and enrolled credits

- 7) If applicable, previous term's grades
- 8) If applicable, signed contract with vocational school
- 9) If applicable, school's list of expenses and/or receipts from school

WHAT IS THE PROGRAM?

Students, who are enrolled TDN citizens, attending an accredited college or vocational school may apply for funding, even if they are still in high school but taking college credits.

HOW MUCH IS IT?

Depending on our program's budget, college students may receive up to \$4,000.00 per academic year. (Usually, \$2,000 per semester, or \$1,333.33 per quarter while enrolled

full-time.) And for vocational schooling, we may cover the full or partial cost of tuition. High school students may receive \$1,000 per academic year.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Enrolled TDN citizens. Students must maintain a GPA of 2.0.

WHEN CAN I APPLY?

Current policy states as soon as possible, and up until the last day of your college's school term. Applications are approved by the Education committee, which typically meets once per month.
